Dirty Work is a high-energy 90s rock band from Adelaide, South Australia, known for their electrifying performances and dedication to the era's sound. The band features Dave Skull on vocals, whose powerful voice drives their dynamic set; Ellen Tefanis on lead guitar, bringing authenticity with her compelling riffs; Joey Bersa on drums, providing a driving rhythm; Scott Armstrong on bass, anchoring the groove with precision; and Benny Gee on rhythm guitar and backing vocals, adding depth and harmonies. Dirty Work debuted at The Gov during Govapalooza 8 in July 2024, delivering a mix of iconic 90s hits and timeless classics. Perfect for private events and live venues, Dirty Work promises a standout performance that energizes and entertains with their genuine 90s rock vibe.




Dave Skull's diverse singing career includes fronting Evenflow (The Australian Pearl Jam Tribute band) from 1993-1998 and later reunions. He led MOSH with over 400 gigs and was featured in Rolling Stone Australia with Hi'ppocrene. Dave also sang for The Others, producing two albums and earning an SA Music Hall of Fame induction in 2015. He fronted FIVEagainstONE from 2018-2023 and played and promoted GOVAPALOOZA events in Adelaide, primarily at the legendary venue, The Gov.

Ellen Tefanis is a talented guitarist and singer-songwriter known for her performances with Keith Urban and Reece Mastin, and her frequent trips to Nashville. Endorsed by Music Man, Ernie Ball, and Orange Amps, she is recognised for her exceptional guitar skills. Ellen has two award-nominated songs and has been invited to showcase her talent at NAMM in Anaheim, highlighting her significant influence and dedication to the music industry.



This dynamic drummer, **Joey Bersa**, has made a mark across Adelaide with bands such as In Bloom (a Nirvana tribute) and the alternative duo Hivemind. Known for his aggressive, intricate style, Joey combines powerful rhythms with precise, technical flair. His innovative approach, heavily influenced by the raw energy of '90s music and modern drumming techniques, drives the band and gives Dirty Work a distinctive, high-octane edge.

Scott Armstrong's passion for music began early, but it was in high school that he committed to learning the bass. After graduation, he pursued further education with a diploma in music from TAFE and a bachelor's degree in jazz from the Elder Conservatorium of Music. Scott's influences span jazz, metal, hip hop, and rock bands like Led Zeppelin, Black Sabbath, Van Halen, KISS, and The Beatles. He is actively involved in the local music scene and plays in one of the main bands, Sub-Stance.



Benny Gee is a seasoned performer with 20 years of experience in the music industry. He has shared the stage with notable artists such as Dave Gleeson and Stu Rudd, as well as other well-known local talents. Benny is a versatile multi-instrumentalist, skilled in rhythm guitar, lead guitar, mandolin, bass, drums, and hand percussion. As a singer-songwriter, he has played over 400 shows and has travelled interstate multiple times for performances. Benny is also a reliable fill-in musician for various bands.
